You can either use our King Henry's Taverns app to order and pay. The app can be downloaded onto your phone using the link on the homepage of our website. The alternative is ordering at the bar at the screen at the till.	Wear a mask or visor even if you have had both vaccines. Wear a lanyard if you are exempt. Although mask wearing is no longer law, it is a recommendation.
You can play on a games machine. Please sanitise your hands before and after playing the games machine or wash your hands for 20 seconds using antibacterial soap.	All tables are to be cleaned and sanitised between each party and any other touch points.
There will be menus on your table.	Wash your hands for 20 seconds or more after clearing a table.
Outside seating and tables are available as well as indoors.	Glasses are to held near the base when taking to the table or collecting from the table.
Your food and drink will be bought to your table. If you order at the bar you can take your drinks to your own table.	Courtesy check backs are to be carried out at least a 1m distance.
Your cutlery, napkins and sauce sachets will be bought to your table.	Keep doors and windows open for ventilation.
If you have any questions during your visit please ask to speak to a Manager or Assistant manager.	Keep your distance from customers and your colleagues during your breaks.
We will keep areas as ventilated as we can.	Please wash your hands or sanitise them on leaving.
Toilets are to be used on a one in - one out basis with signage as a reminder on the door. Again, please wear a mask when you are not at your table.	ALTHOUGH WEARING MASKS IS NOT THE LAW ANY MORE, NOW JUST A RECOMMENDATION, WE WOULD LIKE TO ENCOURAGE CUSTOMERS AND STAFF TO CARRY ON WEARING MASKS OR VISORS DURING THIS TIME OF "GETTING BACK TO NORMAL".
